Suggested activities:

- **Add a visit to historic Stanley to visit Dr Karl Baumgart**
- Riverbend Park – new all abilities park divided into 4 zones – The River Play area, Gorge Play area, Wild Core area, and Urban Plaza. Sky Walk and the ‘confluence net’ – 2 of the largest pieces of play equipment in Australia, bbq facilities, giant mural and a fenced toddler play area.
- Cataract Gorge – 15 min walk from centre of the city. Ride the chairlift through the centre of the Gorge, walking trails, café and restaurant.
- Boardwalk along the Tamar and North Esk Rivers – easy walk with sweeping views of the Cataract Gorge. Bustling marina, cafes and restaurants at the Seaport.
- QVMAG Art Gallery at Royal Park – free entry heritage and contemporary art gallery
- QVMAG Museum at Inveresk – free entry museum and Launceston Planetarium
- Design Tasmania – Tasmanian Wood Design Collection
- Boutique shopping – shops line the city’s avenues, alleyways, squares, streets and malls
- City Park – established in the early 19th Century
- James Boag’s brewery experience
- Launceston Heritage Walks
- Tamar River Cruises
